Harvest Time: Early to Mid October

Aging: Six months in oak

Food Pairings: Enjoyed with most meals, especially red meat, cheeses, or pasta with red meat.

Tasting Notes: Intense bouquet with delicate notes of red-berry fruits, cocoa, and mint. Ruby red in color. Sapid with good texture. Long and delicate finish.

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
